**Parking Garages**

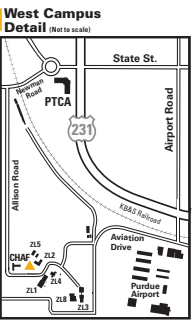
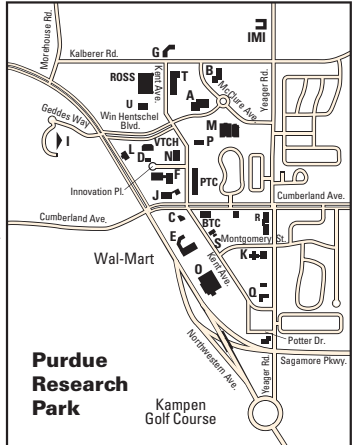
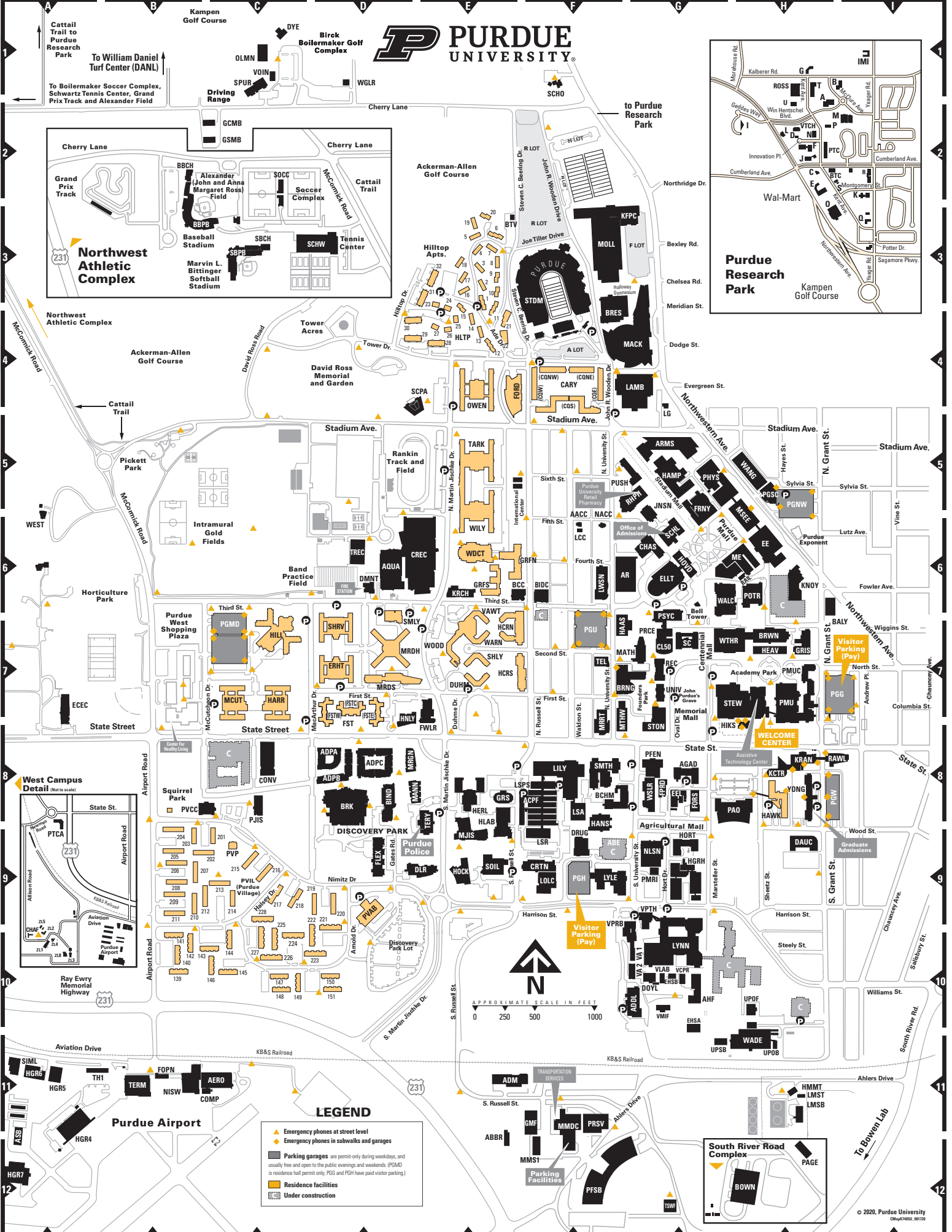
